





1. Playschool - responding to individual differences

For age 2, instruction seeks to build upon what children already know. Through fun themes included in the International Baccalaureate Early Years Curriculum, children develop their enquiry, thinking, reasoning, decision-making, problem solving and mathematical abilities.

The acquisition of English language skills is of key importance, particularly through speaking, phonics and literacy awareness.

Throughout Playschool, learning is enhanced with participation in Physical Education, Music, Arts, Craft and Dance. In a loving and caring environment we encourage respect for one another and the world around us, good manners and appropriate behaviour and run mixed age learning activities.

2. International Baccalaureate (IB) | Primary Years Programme (PYP)

The IBPYP is an international curriculum framework meant for children between the ages 3 and 12 years.

This programme believes that each child has their own personality, learning style and combination of intelligence types. Within a structured framework, students are given an opportunity to explore their own interest and questions. The IBPYP focuses on social, physical, emotional and cultural needs of children as part of a strong academic ethos. It incorporates local & global issues into the curriculum by focussing on six trans-disciplinary themes that are inter-related.

3. Cambridge Lower Secondary Programme. (Cambridge Assessment International Education)

Continuing from our strong Primary Years Programme, DYPIS offers Middle Years curriculum that offers a proactive use of information technology and inquiry-based learning with the development of the essential skills required to successfully complete the robust Cambridge approved International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) Programme undertaken in grades 9 & 10.

The DYPIS Middle School curriculum follows the framework of the Cambridge Lower Secondary Year Programme. This is a three years (Grade 6, 7 and 8) combined programme where students develop knowledge, skills, concepts and attitude which are engaging, challenging and relevant across the subjects of English, Mathematics, Science and Global Perspectives from Cambridge curriculum and History, Geography, Music, Visual Arts & PE from National curriculum.

4. Cambridge Upper Secondary Programme (IGCSE)

The IGCSE offers a flexible course of study that gives candidates the freedom to choose subjects that are right for them, whilst providing them with a broad knowledge base and lifelong skills. Cambridge Assessment International Education prioritizes the development of students who are confident in working with information and ideas - their own and those of others. The students learn to be responsible for themselves, responsible to and respectful of others, reflective as learners, developing their ability to learn.

Subjects Offered:

All the subjects are offered only at the extended curriculum levels. A student is required to do a minimum of 7 subjects from the following groups. All the students must study First Language English and one second language from Group 1; one subject each from Group 2 to 5.

5. International Baccalaureate (IB) | Diploma Programme

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme is a premium entrance qualification to universities, around the world, recognised for its academic integrity, range, and the high level of study skills each student must develop to succeed. A growing number of universities in India and in more than a hundred countries hold IB students in high regard is enough of a testimony to confirm that IB is the board of the future.

Students write 4000 – word independent research paper, giving them an early university experience. The Creativity, Action, Service programme engages students in creative pursuits, physical activities and community service. Through the Theory of Knowledge (TOK), students critically evaluate knowledge claims and judgments.

"The IB Diploma Programme is exceptionally strong in the areas of key cognitive strategies, problem solving, critical thinking, analysis, research and writing skills.

The IB students develop the ability to interpret, analyze, think critically and present arguments."

6. Cambridge AS & A Levels

Cambridge Assessment International Examinations prepares students for life, helping them develop an informed curiosity and a lasting passion for learning. They are a part of Cambridge Assessment International Education a department of the University of Cambridge, UK. The Cambridge Advanced stage of the Cambridge curriculum includes Cambridge International AS & A Levels qualification (equivalent to Grades 11 and 12 in India), and is typically for learners aged 16 to 19 years who need advanced study to prepare for university and higher education.

The qualifications aim to develop student's knowledge, understanding & skills through:

- In-depth subject content
- Independent thinking
- Applying knowledge and understanding to new as well as familiar situations
- Handling and evaluating different types of information source
- Thinking logically and presenting ordered and coherent arguments
- Making judgments, recommendations and decisions
- Presenting reasoned explanations, understanding implications and communicating them logically and clearly
- Working and communicating in English

Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS)

Creativity Activity Service (CAS) is one of the three elements of the IB Diploma Programme core, along with Theory of Knowledge and the Extended Essay.

Through CAS, students strengthen the approaches to learning they develop in their classes, and are encouraged to grow both personally and socially, developing skills such as co-operation, problem solving, conflict resolution and creative and critical thinking as well as developing their own identities.

Students are encouraged to participate in meaningful creativity and to explore their own sense of original thinking and expression. At DYPIS, there are plenty of appropriate creativity opportunities in which students can engage. These creativity experiences could be part of the school's service CAS projects, a school club, time-tabled creativity sessions, or other opportunities. Students are also encouraged to participate in meaningful activity that benefits their physical well-being.



Career Counselling

The Career Counselling Cell at DYPIS aim to help students make more informed educational and career choices. The team support the students to explore different career options, analyze their interest and enhance their strengths by conducting group sessions, workshops and one-on-one meetings throughout the year.


Theatre & Drama

School Facilities

Campus
