MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL





In India, the AS & A Levels have been recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as equivalent to the CBSE/ ICSE/ IB/HSC or any other State Board Exam for Grade 12. A Level students are eligible for all courses whether undergraduate or professional, and are eligible to take all competitive exams in India.


AS & A Levels at D Y Patil International School, Worli

CAMBRIDGE ADVANCED SUBSIDIARY & ADVANCED LEVEL (AS & A LEVELS)

Assessment & Grades

At DYPIS, a staged assessment is followed to an A Level by taking the AS qualification in one examination session (May/June of the first year), and the A2 assessment in a subsequent session (February/March of the second year). There will be regular weekly tests, progression tests, formative Assessments & summative Assessments to equip students for their board assessments.

Each subject that a learner takes at Cambridge AS & A Levels receives a separate grade. The Cambridge International A Level is reported on a grade scale from 'A*' (highest) to 'E' (minimum required performance) and for Cambridge International AS Level, it runs from grade 'A' (Highest) to 'E' (minimum required performance).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- The admission process at DYPIS, Worli begins with the purchase of the school admission kit.
- Application to DYPIS, Worli should be made on the official admissions form, which must be duly completed and submitted with records from the student's previous school as appropriate.
- Once submitted, children applying for AS & A Levels would be called for a written evaluation.
- Only parents of applicants who have been shortlisted based on their performance in Stage I of the written evaluation, will be called for the Stage 2 of the admission which is a meeting with the Admission Panel.
- Based on the outcome of the written assessment & parent meeting, the school's admissions office shall contact only those parents whose wards have been granted admission in the school.
